Academics:

Tarakeswar Degree College is fully aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, under the guidance of the University of Burdwan, commencing from the academic year 2023-24. Previously, the college had implemented the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for its academic programs until the academic session 2022-23. The institution offers a combination of three-year and four-year major courses in Arts, Science, and Commerce, in addition to a self-financed management program.
